

# MINOR IN LATIN AMERICAN & CARIBBEAN STUDIES

Each candidate is expected to complete six courses in at least three different areas for a total of 18 credits. Students may count up to half of the required credits for the Latin American & Caribbean Studies minor (i.e., no more than 9 credits) toward both the minor and their major plan of study.

Knowledge of Spanish or Portuguese is desirable but is not a requirement for the minor.
